

EDUCATION & TRAINING INDUSTRY IN INDIA

India has the world's largest population in the age group of 5-24 years. It is estimated there are about 500 million people who fall in this age bracket. This is where the great growth opportunity for the education sector lies.

It is expected that the education sector in India will be worth US\$ 225 billion by FY 2025. India has one of the largest networks of educational institutes in the world. According to a report from KPMG, India has become the second-largest market after the US when it comes to E-Learning. The online education market grew by 19% in the year 2021. At this juncture, the ed-tech market size is US\$ 700 – 800 million and is expected to reach US\$ 30 billion by 2030.

As of FY 2021, the number of colleges in India reached 42,343 and the number of universities stood at 981. UNESCO has just released the 'State of Education Report for India 2021', and according to the report, he PTR (Pupil-Teacher Ratio) at senior secondary school stands at 47:1 as against 26:1 in the overall school system.

The number of students enrolled in the higher education system for 2019-20 was 38.5 million students (Male – 19.6 million & Female – 18.9 million). The number of females getting enrolled in the higher education system has significantly increased. According to the data released by the Department for the Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT), from April 2000 to September 2021 FDI equity inflows stood at US\$ 6.74 billion.

Some of the major developments the Indian education sector witnessed in the recent past.

According to Times Higher Education Emerging

Economies University Rankings 2022, India has 89 universities behind China with 97 universities and Russia with 100 universities.

- For the Times Higher Education World University Ranking 2022, a total of 71 Indian Institutions have been qualified.
- The investments received by the ed-tech start-up shaves almost doubled from US\$ 2.2 billion in the year 2020 to US\$ 4.7 billion for the year 2021.
- According to the QS employability ranking 2022, we have several Indian Institutes and Universities among the global top 500 universities.

Some of the major initiatives taken by the Indian Government for the education sector

- 100% FDI under automatic route is allowed.
- In the union budget 2022- 23, allocation for Samagra Shiksha Scheme stands at INR 37,383.36 crore compared to INR 31,050.16 crore allotted in FY 22. There has been a 20% increase over the previous year.
- In the year 2020, New Education Policy was introduced to emphasize early childhood care and education.
- In October 2021, the NSDC launched the largest 'Impact Bond' in India with an investment of US\$14.4 million to help 50,000 youngsters to acquire the skills necessary for employment.

Way forward

By the time we reach 2030, it is expected that India's higher education will have a paradigm shift in terms of,

- Learning methods in addition to classroom learning methods.
- Adopting innovative approaches in the higher education system, which can bring a transformational change
- To emerge as the largest global talent provider
- To have more than 20 universities among the top global 200 universities.
- To be one of the top five countries to spend on research.

Over the past several years the educational sector has seen a host of reforms that could transform the country into a knowledge hub.








Things that matter in your career

- Discover your dreams- If you don't have a dream, don't have a vision, and run blindly without any dreams, that would be the utter failure of putting an end to your



Fear of Happiness and how to overcome it.

What is happiness?

What Causes Cherophobia?

Phobia is a physical or a mental fear, the issue where a real one suffers from the condition. Phobia may relate to an event or incident in a person's bygone. The medical conditions and external factors that cause phobia may include:

- A traumatic childhood incident guilt

- Believing that being delighted will lead to something had
- Believing that you should not express gaiety in case it upsets others.
- · Behavioral symptoms:
- Avoidance of joyful gatherings.
- Rejecting relationships or life opportunities that may bring delight and success.

How to defeat Cherophobia?

Cognitive Behavioral Therapy

Talking therapies, such as counseling and psychotherapy are often enormously productive to manage phobias. CBT helps individuals identify unhelpful thinking patterns that may be influencing their chemotherapy and he an individual to deliberately confront their fears, rather than avoid them, by direct and repeated exposure.

Mindfulness:

Mindfulness has also shown positive effects on anxiety outcomes. Mindfulness is developed through meditation techniques that aim to build an awareness of an individual.
